### **Reports**

Chair's Report – All is well.

Secretary Report – All is well

Treasurer Report - The balance brought forward of the Area's Treasury on July 21<sup>st</sup>, 2012 was one hundred ninety-eight dollars and eighty-nine cents (\$198.89). Two groups, **Carrying the Message** (\$10) and **Done with The Past** (\$73) donated a total of eighty-three dollars (\$83.00) to the Area. Rent in the amount of ten dollars (\$10.00) for use of our meeting space was given to Dave V., GSR for **Turning Point** Group. On July 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2012 a Cashier's Check in the amount of one hundred eighteen dollars and eighty cents (\$118.80) payable to AT&T for the Information Line was secured and mailed. This leaves a balance of one hundred fifty-three dollars and nine cents (\$153.09).

AT&T sent a statement in September 2012 showing the monthly charge as forty-one dollars and forty-five cents (\$41.45) which leaves us with a balance due of one dollar and twenty-five cents (\$1.25) for the period of September 5<sup>th</sup> through October 4<sup>th</sup>, 2012. I would like to make one payment to pay the balance due of one dollar and twenty-five cents (\$1.25) along with money to pay for the remainder of the year 2012 and the first four days of January 2013. The total for the current amount due and the next three months totals one hundred twenty-five dollars and sixty cents (\$125.60).
