## **Treasurer's Report:**

Bob F. turned in report showing current balance of one hundred dollars and fifty-seven cents (\$100.57). GoDaddy renewal for website was paid on 06/14/21 and is valid through 06/19/22. Monthly Information Line charges are budgeted but not yet

paid through December 2021 and are eleven dollars and six cents (\$11.06) per month.

It was explained that there is a new option now available for our Information Line offered by the Florida Region. This option is:

*Twilio/Yap – A new phone provider for the RSC. Operates off the BMLT database. The cost is absorbed by the Region. Call the phone number and say which town or zip code and it will give you the five (5) closest meetings by voice and text.*

*We can utilize Twilio/Yap as an automated service with no help line volunteers or it could be changed to having volunteers at any time if Area decides to do so. Or, we could refer callers to another Area or group willing to take the calls.*

This would eliminate the need for our current Information Line a savings of eleven dollars and six cents (\$11.06) per month.

### **Open Forum:**

Jeff G. asked about the need for more frequent ASC meetings.

**Three (3) different proposed Mission Statements were passed out to go back to groups for input. Please bring group decision or suggestions to ASC.**

### **Group Reports:**

Carrying The Message reported that they had just purchased twenty-two (22) soft cover Basic Texts to be donated to the Coquina Coast Area H&I to send to inmates requesting books.
